SUBJECT: State's Average Weekly Wage

On May 6, 2020, in accordance with the provision of Section 25-5-68(c), Code of Alabama 1975, as last amended, the Secretary of Labor determined that the State's average weekly wage for calendar year 2019 was \$920.07.

For injuries occurring on and after July 1, 2020, the maximum workers' compensation payable will be \$920.00 per week, and the minimum compensation will be \$253.00 per week.

Please advise the appropriate personnel in your organization of these changes.

Previous years' maximum and minimum compensation payable as provided under Section 25-5-68 are as follows:
